Dear primary care providers,

Vaccines for Children is a national program providing vaccines at no cost to families and their efforts have been critical through the COVID-19 global health crisis. Providers registered with Vaccines for Children qualify for unique funding opportunities and now, getting registered is easier than ever.

### If you are already registered, you can receive significant funding to support COVID-19 vaccinations:

- **NEW!** Starting April 1, 2022, providers can apply for The KidsVaxGrant for support in COVID-19 vaccination efforts for children. Learn more about the KidsVaxGrant here:
