## Proposition 56 Directed Payments for Family Planning Services

Dear provider,

Timely access to family planning services is vital for many of our community. Through Proposition 56, the Health Plan of San Mateo (HPSM) issues additional payments to providers who offer these services to members.

Qualifying family planning services include long-acting contraceptives, other contraceptives (other than oral contraceptives), and more. For a full list of qualifying services: https://www.dhcs.ca.gov/formsandpubs/Documents/MMCDAPLsandPolicyLetters/APL2023/AP L23-008.pdf

HPSM automatically identifies and distributes payment for eligible claims on a bi-monthly basis. Proposition 56 payments will be paid separate from the claim payment. As of May 2023, all Proposition 56 payments have transitioned to electronic fund transfer (EFT) and electronic remittance advice (ERA) if providers are set up to receive payments that way, however Prop 56 summary reports will continue to be mailed.
