Continuity of Care for Members Transitioning from Medi-Cal Fee-for-Service

Dear providers,

Members who mandatorily transition from Medi-Cal Fee-For-Service to the Health Plan of San Mateo (HPSM) on or after January 1, 2023 have a right to request continuity of care (COC) with providers they were previously seeing. Members can request continuity of care with a provider for up to 12 months or for the duration of certain conditions if they have a verifiable pre-existing relationship with the provider.

These conditions and their time limits for COC include:

- Acute: For the duration of the condition.
- Serious Chronic: For the complete course of treatment and safe transfer to another provider.
- Pregnancy and Postpartum Care: For the duration of the pregnancy and immediate postpartum period of 12 months.
- Terminal Illness: For the duration of the terminal illness. This may exceed 12 months.
- Care of a Newborn Child between Birth and Age 36 Months: Must not exceed 12 months.
- Surgery or other procedure authorized by HPSM as part of a course of treatment that has been recommended and documented: Must occur within 180 days.
