Here's a brief overview of the four grants:

- The **Primary Care Team Expansion Grant** is for hiring and integrating new interprofessional team members. The funding provides the upfront dollars to hire, operationalize and sustain new interprofessional team member roles that will increase primary care team capacity. <https://www.hpsm.org/about-us/community-impact/primary-care-investment-strategy/grants/primary-care-team-expansion-grant>
- The **Core Team Stabilization Grant** is for recruiting and retaining primary care providers and medical assistants. - The **Provider Sabbatical Grant** is for retaining providers by enhancing resilience through sabbatical. This funding rewards long-term primary care providers for their service and
